- EFE Mission Statement: Preparing Today's Students for Tomorrow's Careers
- Students enrolled in an EFE course have a 95.9% graduation rate.
- EFE students who have completed their programs have a 98.1% post-secondary/employment placement rate.
- 74 of 75 Outstanding 12-13 EFE Seniors received EFE scholarships and cash awards, equivalent to \$59,700.
- Over **745** 12-13 EFE students received the opportunity for college credit at KVCC through their EFE programs.
- Approximately 400 businesses in the community partner with EFE programs and EFE advisory committees.
