KCR4s 3-year-old Programs	Groups A, B, C, & D	0 - 200%
GSRP (Priority - turns 4 by Sept. 1)	Groups C, D, E, & F	101 - 300%
KCR4s 4-year-old Programs	Groups G & H	301 - 400%

Factors Contributing to Educational Risk
Diagnosed Disability or Identified Developmental Delay (IEP)
Abuse/Neglect of Child or Parent
Parent(s) with Low Educational Attainment
Primary Home Language Other Than English
Severe or Challenging Behaviors
Environmental Risk (if homeless)

*Over-income can only make up 15% of enrolled students (GSRP)

**Over-income can only make up 10% of enrolled students (Head Start)

***Ongoing Cash Assistance – SSI, TANF, SNAP
