<b>Head Start 3- and 4-year-old Programs</b>	Groups A & B	0 - 100% (***Foster, Ongoing Cash Assistance, Homeless)
<b>KCR4s 3-year-old Programs</b>	Groups A, B, C, & D	0 - 200%
<b>GSRP (Priority - turns 4 by Sept. 1)</b>	Groups C, D, E, & F	101 - 300%
<b>KCR4s 4-year-old Programs</b>	Groups G & H	301 - 400%

Diagnosed Disability or Identified Developmental Delay (IEP)
Abuse/Neglect of Child or Parent
Parent(s) with Low Educational Attainment
Primary Home Language Other Than English
Severe or Challenging Behaviors
Environmental Risk (if homeless)
