

## **Kalamazoo County Early/Middle College Bus Hub Transportation Options for 2020-21**

### School districts and level of participation in the EFE/EFA/EMC bus hub:

Full time participation (all three sessions) – Comstock, Kalamazoo, Portage, Vicksburg

Part time participation – Galesburg 1<sup>st</sup> session only (7:45-9:15 classes)

No participation – Climax-Scotts, Gull Lake, Parchment, Schoolcraft

### Transportation will be available to the KVCC Texas Township Campus for the following class times:

Classes between 7:45-9:15 am, transportation **to and from KVCC**. Students could stay for another class from 9:30-10:50 and take the 11:24 bus back to the hub. Refer to the bus hub schedule for exact pick up and drop off times at your home school.

Classes that begin at 12:30 pm or after, transportation **to KVCC only**. Students who ride the bus from school to home at the end of the school day must find their own transportation back from KVCC. The last bus back to the hub to catch home busses leaves before KVCC afternoon classes end.

### Dates that bus hub doesn't operate

The bus hub operates on the high school schedules. Therefore, **the following dates that KVCC is in session do not have bus transportation: October 30 (end of marking period), November 25 (Thanksgiving break), January 22 (end of semester), February 26 (mid-Winter break), March 26-31, April 1-2 (high school spring break), and April 13-15 (SAT and other State testing days in high schools, these dates are subject to change)**. Five of these dates are Fridays and KVCC has very few Friday classes.

### Important Reminders

It is very important that students understand they must head directly to class when they arrive at KVCC. Bus drop off times are usually very close to class start times. KVCC Instructors expect you to be on time to class. The bus timing will not be an acceptable reason for being tardy.

It is also important that students head directly for the bus when their classes end. Bus pick up times are usually very close to class end times. The bus must leave at the scheduled time so it can return to the hub and get students back to their high schools.
