#### **Student Instructions**

Please complete pages 3 & 4 and return to your school counselor as soon as possible. **Each high school has designated a due date for EFE applications to be submitted.** Please check with your school counselor for this date and be sure to submit your application in a timely manner. Please keep pages 1 & 2 for your reference. Page two lists enrollment considerations for some EFE programs.

#### **Enrollment Considerations**

Certain EFE courses require special supplies, extended hours, specific clothing, and/or proof of immunizations. Other courses, not listed, may also have considerations as determined by the instructor. Certain requirements may be mandated by the state, may represent a requirement of the industry, and may be subject to change. Detailed requirements for each EFE course are provided on the first day of class. Please contact the course instructor with any questions BEFORE enrolling.

#### **Aviation Technology**

- Strongly recommend students have a solid background in math and science
- Dual-enrolled class with Kellogg Community College. Students must follow dual-enrollment policies

#### **Conservation Biology**

- · Second Year (internships)
- · Second Year Drivers Only

#### **Construction Trades**

- Students are expected to dress appropriately for working in all kinds of weather conditions
- · Student may be responsible for transportation

#### Cosmetology/Barbering (C/B)

- C/B has an added step to the application. See your counselor for more information.
- · Students will be making a two-year commitment to this program
- · Students are expected to follow the beauty school's dress code
- Students must meet the min. performance hour requirement to remain in class; including summer hours (between Jr/Sr year)
- Students are responsible for all program costs sustained beyond high school graduation
- C/B class time is daily from 12:30-4:30

#### Dental Assisting\*\*

- Student must fulfill the requirements of the KVCC Health packet (SAT minimum, physical, proof of immunizations, drug test, and Live Scan fingerprinting)
- · Extended hours: Students provide own transportation
- Students must meet academic and attendance requirements to be recommended for 2nd semester and internship
- · Lab days and internships require uniforms

#### **Electrical Technology\*\***

- · Students provide own transportation
- · Students are expected to dress appropriately for working in a lab

#### **Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)\*\***

- Student must fulfill the requirements of the KVCC Health packet (SAT minimum, physical, proof of immunizations, drug test, and Live Scan fingerprinting)
- · Extended hours: Students provide own transportation
- Students must meet academic and attendance requirements to continue. This may be as early as 7 ½ weeks into fall and winter semesters.
- · Clinical experience requires uniform

#### Fund. of Health Science & Health Science

- Students must fulfill the requirements of the program's Health Packet (physical, proof of immunizations, drug test, and criminal background check) if electing to participate in workplace opportunities
- Dress code enforced during lab and job shadowing experiences
- · Students provide own transportation to job shadow experiences

#### **OPTIONAL**

- Extended hours: 20 + for community service and HOSA participation
- Potential fundraising or out-of-pocket expenses for HOSA attendance

#### Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning (HVAC)\*\*

- · Students provide own transportation
- · Students are expected to dress appropriately for working in a lab

#### **Law Enforcement**

- Every day, polo shirt and dress pants are to be worn as selected by team
- Male student's hair must be no longer than 1 ½ inch. Female student's hair must be tied back.
- · Physical training is part of this class
- A student's unlawful behavior may exclude or remove them from the program
- Student should demonstrate good reading and writing comprehension

#### **Teacher Academy**

- This rigorous academic course includes a 4-day internship and 1-day EFE class each week, in addition to homework/outside class projects. Students must be eager to work with children as well as complete classwork.
- Appropriate internship attire is required. No short skirts, high heels, visible tattoos must be covered; no body/facial piercings (except for ear piercings).

#### **Veterinary Science\***

- Students must provide own transportation 2nd semester for internship
- Strongly recommend students have successfully passed Biology
- Students must meet academic and attendance requirements to be placed in an internship.
- Blended learning

#### OPTIONAL

- Extended hours: 20 + for community service and FFA participation
- Potential fundraising or out-of-pocket expenses for FFA attendance

#### Welding\*\*

- Students provide own transportation
- Students are expected to dress appropriately for working in a lab
- Supplies required will be addressed at program orientation in May

#### Please note:

- · Due to local, state, and federal rules and regulations, these special requirements may need to be modified throughout the school year.
- Transportation for any EFE program is dependent upon local school district policy. Please speak with your counselor.
- Details pertaining to these special requirements will be explained the first week of class.
