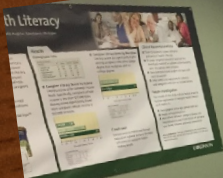
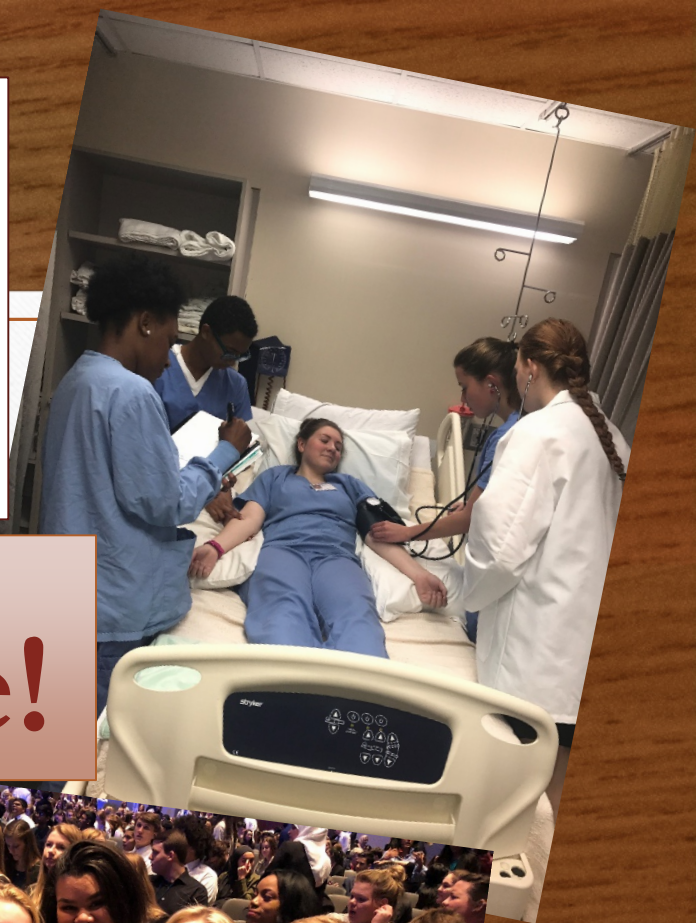

- Kalamazoo's State Approved Career and Technical Education (CTE) Programs
- **Approximate Enrollment is 2,400 students countywide (11 public high schools, 4 non-public, alternative and home-schooled students)**
- The EFE/CTE Countywide Partnership Provides Students with 30 Different Programs
 - 26 locations
- **Open to any 11th-12th grade students in the county**
