


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
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The purpose of the KRESA Focused Learning Experience (KFLEx) program is to provide students grades 6-12 in Kalamazoo County additional opportunities for those that desire a different way to "do school".

KFLEx provides an individualized learning plan and engaging curriculum in an online setting to students residing in Kalamazoo County.

KFLEx provides multiple methods and modalities of learning such as individualized instruction, integrated curriculum, and real-world project learning to create meaningful learning experiences for students.



Students participating in KFLEx have an individualized learning plan intended to provide engaging curriculum and elective experiences in an online setting personalized to support student learning needs and interests. Students may participate in full virtual courses with core content and elective courses provided through Accelerate Education. Project Learning Elective Experiences are available in multi-grade courses for 6-8 and 9-11. Work-Based Learning Experiences focus on career planning, employability skills and internships for students in grades 11-12.

All courses in this catalog must be approved by participating district's School Board of Education and are open to all eligible students.

COURSE IDENTIFICATION

- Courses are identified as Core or Electives
- Core courses and some elective courses are supported through the Accelerate Curriculum Courses identified under "Elective Experiences" are support through Kalamazoo RESA Curriculum Development or Education for the Arts Curriculum
- **Canvas** is the learning management system (LMS) that supports the online learning. It allows teachers to post grades, information, and assignments online
- > Project Learning Experience = 3 trimester elective experiences that utilize project-based learning in which students learn by actively engaging in real-world and personally meaningful projects
- **Work-Based Learning Experience =** Full year experience that includes employability skills development and internship
- **EFA Electives** Education for the Arts courses
- **CAE** Career Awareness and Exploration courses

KFLEx Elective Experiences

Project Learning Experience (grades 9-11)

The course is designed based on a multi-age problem of practice with real world project-based experiences. Students will be actively engaged in the creation of an end product that will be presented to an authentic audience. The focus on local challenges and inquiry-based research and development will allow for growth in leadership, collaboration, creation, and empathy.

The course will meet synchronously based on a regular schedule with asynchronous work that will be completed individually and in small work groups.

Integrated PBL Experience (Multi-grade 9-11) ~ 3 Trimester Course

Work-Based Learning Experience (grades 11 & 12 only) – Maximum of 40 students This course is offered on a semester schedule only

Work-based learning experience allows students to participate in internships in their interested career field receiving on the job experiences and work-based skills to increase employability opportunities.
