- Work with professional theatre artists to find and develop your voice as an artist.
- Have access to all the different theatres in Kalamazoo by attending several productions.
- Expand your knowledge or learn the basic techniques of acting, playwriting and directing.
- Study the great authors and playwrights to aid you in creating your own unique theatre experience.
- Perform a minimum of one production per semester of your own work.
- Participate in daily workshops that will aid your critical thinking skills.
- Use many different tools to tell a story: cameras, music, rhythms and silence.
- Study different forms of playwriting: Performance Poetry, Hip-Hop Theatre, Theatre Graffiti.
- Receive Visual, Performing, Applied Arts credit.
- Receive required 12th grade Language Arts credit.
