As parent/guardian and student participants in the Kalamazoo County Early/Middle College program, we are indicating that we understand and agree to the terms and conditions listed below by initialing each statement:

We understand that the Kalamazoo County Early/Middle College (EMC) program is an option						
for all eligible high school students and that students must apply prior to junior year in order						
to be considered.						
We understand that enrollment in the EMC program involves being enrolled in high school						
for a total of five years (grades 9-13). We understand that EMC students will not be eligible						
for their high school diploma until the completion of grade 13.						
We understand that EMC students are expected to complete at least one of the following, in						
addition to the high school diploma, by the end of grade 13: an Associate degree, 60+						
transferable credits, an occupational certificate, a Michigan Early/Middle College Association						
(MEMCA) Technical Certificate, or the right to participate in a registered apprenticeship.						
We understand that if an EMC student does not earn an associate degree, 60+ transferable						
credits, or an occupational certificate, the student is expected to fulfill the requirements of						
the MEMCA certificate. This includes Michigan Merit Curriculum, minimum of 15						
transferable college credits, and either 40 hours of verified career exploration, internship, job						
shadowing, clinical experience, or 100 hours of verified community service (or a combination						
of the two that equals 70+ hours).						
We understand that EMC students are required to successfully complete a math-related						
course in grade 13.						
We understand that EMC students are required to meet with a designated Coach through						
grade 13. The goals of the meetings shall include discussing academic progress, developing						
success strategies, connecting students with resources, and assisting students with their						
transition from high school students to college students.						
We understand that placement testing may be required in order to determine appropriate						
college course placement and that it is the student's responsibility to arrange a time to						
complete placement testing either at the college or at the high school (if available).						
We understand that EMC students are expected to attend their annual EMC cohort events:						
EMC Kickoff for 11 th graders, EMC Refresh for 12 th graders and EMC Rising 5 th Year for 13 th

We understand that EMC students must attend and pass all required high school classes, CTE classes and program-approved college courses through the end of grade 13.		
We understand that the cost of college tuition, fees and required materials for approved EMC courses will be paid up to an allocated amount per class as determined by the district in which the student is enrolled. We also understand that any costs above the allocated amount will be the responsibility of the student and/or parent.		
We understand that we will be responsible to repay the school district any tuition costs that were expended by the school district for failure to successfully complete a district paid post-secondary course. We understand that we will be responsible to reimburse the school district for the non-completed courses prior to the start of the next semester.		
We understand that EMC students are expected to meet with a college academic advisor each semester and are responsible for enrolling in approved courses towards the degree program.		
We understand that EMC students must follow and adhere to both the high school academic calendar and the college calendar (may differ for Spring Breaks, holidays, etc.).		
We understand that some courses offered on a college campus may involve content not typically taught or considered appropriate in high schools. Students may encounter adult or controversial subject matter. In addition, we also understand that EMC students may be exposed to college aged and adult students during their participation on the college campus.		
We understand that remedial college courses, most activity courses, and religious courses do not qualify for tuition support through dual enrollment.		
We understand that transportation to the college is the responsibility of the student/parent.		
We understand that EMC students are enrollees of their school district through grade 13 and the laws, policies, and graduation requirements still apply.		
We understand that EMC students are subject to student academic and disciplinary standards and policies of the district in which the student is enrolled and the school district and/or college campus where college courses are located.		
We understand that EMC students will be held responsible for any inappropriate or offensive communications or actions as part of their participation in the EMC and use of the equipment is governed by the applicable technology code of conduct and student code of conduct policies.
