



## Aviation Technology Articulated and Dual Enrollment Credit 21-22

### Articulated Credit Requirements

1. Kellogg CC requires the completion of a Kellogg Community College application within 26 months of high school graduation. Student must apply for credit at the college within two years of completion of the KRESA Aviation program.
2. Student must earn a final grade of B or higher in each semester or every trimester offered.
3. Student must have teacher recommendation.

These courses are part of a bridge program between KCC and WMU College of Aviation. In order for credits to transfer to WMU, students must achieve a minimum grade of 2.0 for all work at KCC. Your instructor will inform you of procedures for application.

<i>AVG161</i> Mechanics for Pilots	3

Students must be accepted into the NMC Aviation program and enroll at NMC. Credits will be awarded following submission of NMC Application for Articulation Credits. Credits must be requested within two years of completion of the KRESA program. Students must provide evidence of a passing score on the FAA Private Pilot Written Exam to satisfy requirements for *AVG 101* credit.
