At the end of the trimester/semester, Cindy Goss will send an email to the CTE Instructor requesting information on students who are eligible for articulated credit. Cindy will also send a Google form for students to fill out to request their certificate.

Students are emailed a certificate of eligibility for credit. They must print it and take it in person to the KVCC registration office with their high school transcript.

Please note it may take up to two weeks for credits to appear on KVCC transcripts.

MCTI

Students must apply for articulated credit within 26 months of high school graduation. Students must complete a request form for an articulated high school course with their high school counselor and send it to MCTI with their application for admission.
