## **Articulated Credit Requirements**

- 1. Student must apply for credit at the college within two years of high school graduation.
- 2. Student must earn a final grade of B or higher in each semester or every trimester offered.
- 3. Student must have teacher recommendation.

EDMT103, EDMT105 and EDMT220 are in the Machine Tool Technology Associate of Applied Science (AAS) and the Machinist Certificate.

EDMT103 is in the Machine Tool Operator Certificate of Achievement.
