



## Computerized Manufacturing Articulated Credit and Early/Middle College Options 21-22

### Articulated Credit Requirements

1. Student must apply for credit at the college within two years of high school graduation.
2. Student must earn a final grade of B or higher in each semester or every trimester offered.
3. Student must have teacher recommendation.

### Early/Middle College Options with KVCC

*EDMT103*, *EDMT105* and *EDMT220* are in the Machine Tool Technology Associate of Applied Science (AAS) and the Machinist Certificate.

*EDMT103* is in the Machine Tool Operator Certificate of Achievement.

Students must enroll in the EMC program by fall of their junior year of high school.
