Articulated Credit Requirements

- 1. Student must apply for credit within 26 months of high school graduation.
- 2. Student must earn a final grade of B or higher in both semesters.
- 3. Student must be enrolled in the Woodworking Career Alliance and have earned a Sawblade Certificate.
- 4. Students must successfully complete one semester at MCTI to receive the articulated credit.
- 5. Students must complete a request form for an articulated high school course with their high school counselor and send it to MCTI with their application for admission.
- 6. Student must have teacher recommendation.
