Articulated Credit Requirements

- 1. Student must apply for credit at KVCC and Ferris State within two years of high school graduation. Baker College requires application within 12 months. Students at Davenport must begin attending within 27 months from the date of graduation.
- 2. Student must earn a final grade of B or higher in each semester or every trimester offered. Baker College requires a B- or better in the same terms.
- 3. Student must have teacher recommendation.
