Articulated Credit Requirements

1. Student must apply for credit KVCC within two years of high school graduation. Baker College requires application within 12 months. Davenport requires attendance within 27 months of graduation.
2. Student must earn a final grade of B or higher in each semester or every trimester offered. Baker College requires a B- or better in the same terms.
3. Student must have teacher recommendation.
