Phlebotomy Training

Are you interested in **FREE** training as a Phlebotomist with employers who are ready to hire? These jobs are in demand and the pay is great!

The training will take place at The Groves of Kalamazoo Valley Community College every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 4:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. starting June 14th and will run through August 18th.

The training also includes three weeks of full-time clinicals which take place the last three weeks of the training. You will be placed amongst various clinical lab locations in Southwest Michigan.

Upon completion of the program and a passing score on the national test, you will be eligible for **National Certification for Phlebotomy Technicians** through the American Society for Clinical Pathology. There may also be an opportunity for you to earn a **US Department of Labor Apprenticeship Certificate**.
