



PrePrimary Evaluation Team

The P.E.T. program provides developmental assessment and planning for children ages 0-6 who reside within one of the following school districts: Climax-Scotts, Comstock, Galesburg-Augusta, Gull Lake, Kalamazoo, Parchment, Portage, Schoolcraft, or Vicksburg.

Any interested parent(s) may refer their preschool age child suspected of significant developmental delays in the following areas: physical, mental, vision, hearing, speech and language. Assessment is also provided for children demonstrating characteristics of autism.

As part of the evaluation process, parents are aided in investigating all appropriate programs available for their child. These programs may be offered by the family's local school district, through the Kalamazoo Regional Educational Service Agency (K/RESA) or other community agencies.
