




What is Education for Employment (EFE)?

- State approved career and technical education (CTE) programs
- Approximate enrollment is 2,400 students countywide (11 public high schools, 4 non-public, alternative and home schooled students)
- EFE's countywide partnership provides students with 38 different programs
- Open to any 10th-12th grade student in the county
