PLEASE NOTE School drill reporting will close on Sept. 15 in accordance with the Act. Once you have submitted the schools drill schedule, you MUST complete the drill on the date and time you have committed to. Public Act 12 of 2014 only allows for a drill date to be changed when a scheduled drill could not occur due to conditions not within the control of school authorities such as severe storms, fires, epidemics, utility power unavailability, water or sewer failure, or a health condition AS DEFINED BY THE COUNTY OR STATE HEALTH AUTHORITIES. In this situation, the drill must be rescheduled to occur within 10 school days after the original scheduled date of the cancelled drill and the Chief Administrator of the District notifies the County Emergency Management Coordinator of the rescheduled drill date. A schedule change notification to the County Emergency Management Coordinator must be made to 269-385-6144. Please remember if your drill is cancelled due to one of the above events it still must be conducted within 10 school days of your originally scheduled drill.

Three of the fire drills shall be held by December 1 of the school year, and 2 shall be held during the remaining part of the school year, with a reasonable spacing interval between each drill.

Drills conducted under this subsection shall include security measures that are appropriate to an emergency such as the release of a hazardous material or the presence of a potentially dangerous individual on or near the premises.
