



Each year the Kalamazoo County Education for Employment (EFE) program offers state-approved career and technical education to any 10th - 12th grade students at high schools and business training sites throughout Kalamazoo County. EFE programs prepare young people for employment or post-secondary experiences in a broad range of occupations representing six state-identified career pathways. Training and services are offered under the guidance of certified teachers, counselors, administrators and career specialists. Participants must enroll through their resident public school district and have completed their high school requirements for junior or senior status.
